



Bachelor/Master Study Paths: Teaching at Secondary Schools (highest stratification level 'Gymnasium')

Combination of the subjects Bio/Ch, Ch/Math, Math/Inf, Math/Ph, Ph/Inf

Study Paths and Graduations

The study programme towards a high school teacher consists of

- Bachelor studies (6 semesters including the Bachelor thesis),
- consecutive Master studies (4 semesters) and
- a compulsory preparation phase as in-service teacher (traineeship).

The first academic degree is the „Bachelor of Education“.

Polyvalent studies: A possible change to the scientific Bachelor allows a real free election, partly with bridging modules if necessary. Thus, science education studies are no “one way street“ as before.

After the Master studies, the first State Examination needs to be passed. It entitles an entry to the preparation-phase as in-service teacher.

The Master thesis will be prepared in in a 4th semester of the Master Studies or coupled with the second thesis of the 2. State Examination within the traineeship phase.

Successful Master studies with a completed Master thesis lead to the academic degree „Master of Education“.

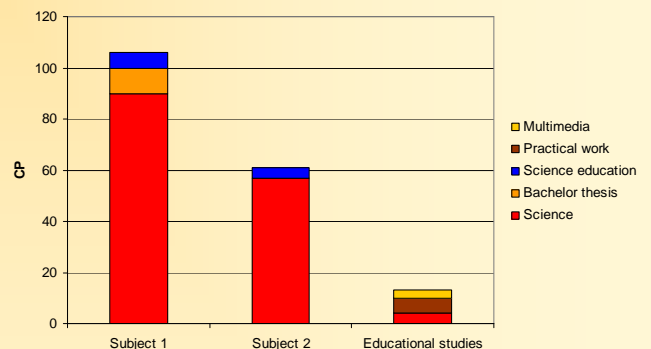
