- A3: Flood protection taking into account the requirements of the european water framework directive
- A4: Possible concept for flood protection as one essential contribution to the bavarian Garden Festival in the year 2016


## Part B: Adaptation strategies - soft an ecological approach and private precaution

- B1: Renaturation of the river in the city - the city at the river: Combining flood protection, ecology and quality of life in the city
- B2: Private precautionary measures: Alone with floods or prospects? Create a possible concept.
- B3: Improvement of flood-forecasting linked with mobile temporary flood protection systems
