



## **Guideline:**

## CV of the Experienced Researcher applying for a MSCA Individual Fellowship

The CV is intrinsic to the evaluation of the whole proposal (...). It should be limited to maximum 5 pages and should include **the standard academic and research record.** Any research career gaps and/or unconventional paths should be clearly explained so that this can be fairly assessed by the independent evaluators.

The *experienced researchers* must provide a list of achievements reflecting their track record, and this may include, if applicable:

- 1. **Publications** in **peer-reviewed scientific journals, peer-reviewed conference proceedings and/or monographs** of their respective research fields, indicating also the number of citations (excluding selfcitations) they have attracted.
- 2. Granted **patent(s)**.
- 3. **Research monographs, chapters** in collective volumes and any translations thereof.
- 4. **Invited presentations** to peer-reviewed, internationally established conferences and/or international advanced schools.
- 5. **Research expeditions** that the *experienced researcher* has led.
- 6. **Organisation of International conferences** in the field of the researcher (membership in the steering and/or programme committee).
- 7. Examples of participation in industrial innovation.
- 8. Prizes and Awards.
- 9. Funding received so far
- 10. Supervising, mentoring activities, if applicable.
