Description of planned research action for MSCA Individual Fellowship proposals

In the MSCA IF proposal, excellence and impact of the research/innovation action of the fellow are one of the core parts, besides the quality of training/knowledge transfer as well as the quality of supervision.

In your application for the BayCEER MSCA IF Initiating Workshop, please describe your planned research according to the following lines (2 page draft, co-authored with your potential host supervisor):

- 1. State-of-the-art, objectives and overview of the action
- 2. **Research methodology and approach**: highlight the type of research / innovation activities proposed
- 3. **Originality and innovative aspects** of the research programme: explain the contribution that the action is expected to make to advancements within the action field (e.g. novel concepts, approaches or methods that will be employed).
- 4. **Expected impact on your career prospects** Which new competences will be acquired?
- 5. Benefits for the European society To what extent may competences acquired during the fellowship, including any secondments, increase your positive impact on European society / science base and/or the economy?
